Many residents of South Florida suffer from lack of access to healthcare. Those without coverage are among the most severely affected by the failures of U.S. healthcare.

We all know someone whose *life and health* hang in the balance as our elected officials hide their heads in piles of lobbyists' cash and refuse to acknowledge that healthcare is a human right, and that **Medicare for All** is the only way to ensure we join the rest of the developed world in enjoying it.





Medicare for All (also called “single-payer”, as one accountable public agency finances medical costs for all) has been a goal of reformers for more than a century. Relentless lobbying from the very profitable insurance industry has so far limited its reach to the elderly and chronically ill.

Now, with **27,000,000** Americans left *uninsured* under the ACA, and **24,000,000** more *threatened* by a bought congress, people across the country are finding their voice and demanding, as one, their right to healthcare.

Other developed countries have implemented single-payer systems with great success, and virtually every other highly developed country has found a way to assure *all* their citizens have access to healthcare. The moment for the United States to join them is now. Medicare for all is the way to do it.

MEDICARE FOR ALL

Simply: *all* residents of the U.S. covered for all medically necessary services:

doctors' fees, hospital fees, preventive care, long-term care, mental health care, reproductive care, dental, vision, prescription drugs, & medical supplies.

Funded by a modest, progressive tax and by the *huge savings* to be had by remaking our horribly complex and fragmented for-profit system.

We already pay enough for Medicare for All, we just don't get it!

No premiums, no deductibles, no co-pays. Just essential care when your family needs it.

Being released from the control of insurers, patients will have their choice of physicians and hospitals.
