



You might have heard that UPS workers are ready to strike on August 1 if they don't get a fair contract.

Through the pandemic they've delivered record profits for UPS. But the company will blame "greedy workers" for the shutdown.

UPS CEO Carol Tome made \$19 million last year. A part-time UPS workers would have to work for 1,347 years at \$15.50 to earn that much!

UPS can avoid a strike by delivering what workers deserve:

- ✓ **And end to Part-Time Poverty:** A majority of UPS workers are part-time employees making poverty wages. They want higher wages and more full-time jobs.
- ✓ **Equal Pay for Equal Work:** UPS wants to pay some drivers less to do the same job. Teamsters say no way.
- ✓ **No More Excessive Overtime:** For many Teamsters, the rallying cry is "I don't want to be a part-time parent."

UPS Teamsters are fighting to set a higher standard for all workers. Will you stand with them?
